This RFP is part of the second phase of BAC's Domestic Terminal Redevelopment. BAC completed stage one in 2016 with a \$15 million upgrade of the southern terminal (predominantly accommodating Virgin Australia services) and commenced the \$40 million stage two, to upgrade the northern and central terminals, in mid-2018.
