Alipay and AlipayHK users will receive an additional bonus of up to HK\$600 (US\$76) when settling their payment. To take part in the promotion and redeem the Airport e-coupons, travelers need to download the HKG My Flight app and register as a member.

HKIA is an international and regional air hub connecting 220 destinations around the world, including 50 mainland cities. In 2018, HKIA reached a record 74.7 million passengers.
