

## Bottega presents wine and grappa from Bolgheri at Prowein in Düsseldorf

On the last day of Prowein in Düsseldorf (March 26), Bottega has announced that it will present a wine and a grappa from the famed Bolgheri area. Bolgheri is a village in the municipality of Castagneto Carducci that is at the heart of Maremma, located on the foothills of the Colline Metallifere. Bottega notes that the grapes grown in the region are excellent for a number of different types of wine.

Il Vino dei Poeti Bolgheri Rosso Doc., to be presented at the exhibition on March 26, is described as an intense ruby red wine with garnet tinges that are the result of a selection of Cabernet, Syrah and Sangiovese grapes. Alexander Exquisite, the special grappa that will be showcased on the same day, is the first aged grappa of the Alexander brand, obtained from a rare selection of marcs coming from the Bolgheri zone.
